The South Bay Workforce Investment Board (SBWIB) has announced the availability of National Emergency Grant (NEG) funding on a first come/first serve basis for workers who have been displaced from the *High Technology and Transportation* industries. The date of the lay-off or lay-off notices must have occurred between January 1, 2003 and June 30, 2004. Eligible workers must be enrolled with SBWIB no later than September 15, 2004.

At this time, only "training" funds are available. If you wish to take advantage of this funding, your eligible participants must be dually enrolled in the appropriate NEG grant as well as the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Dislocated Worker program operated by your agency.

The SBWIB will be conducting a technical assistance workshop to discuss MIS and fiscal procedures associated with this NEG grant program with MIS, Fiscal representatives and other WorkSource staff as follows:
