This bulletin is being issued to provide the County's current WIA Service Providers with U.S. Department of Labor (DOL) Employment and Training Administration's (ETA) overview of the implementation strategy for Workforce Investment Act (WIA) funding under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009.

**Purpose**

The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009 (ARRA) was signed into law by President Obama on February 17, 2009. Employment and Training Administration (ETA) will issue formal guidance within 30 days of enactment for implementation of the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) under the Recovery Act. Employment and Training Administration (ETA) issued Training and Employment Notice (TEN) 30-08 which describes the initial plans ETA has developed for implementing WIA under ARRA.
