TO: ALL WIA SCHOOL/SCHOOL DISTRICTS YOUTH PROVIDERS

The purpose of this bulletin is to advise all WIA Schools/School Districts Youth service providers of a Solicitation For Proposal that has been issued by the California Workforce Investment Board (CalWIB) in conjunction with the California Department of Education to establish a Southern California Communities and Schools for Career Success (CS2) site. Funding is for 36 months with an expected award of \$425,000. Only one site will be awarded.

The proposal targets large schools/school districts with an enrollment of over 50,000 students interested in using the principles developed under CS2 to help connect the K-12 and the so-called "Second chance" systems to create one system that effectively serves all youth.

The Los Angeles County Workforce Investment Board (LACWIB)/Youth Council is a mandatory partner in this project. Interested parties should submit a formal letter, requesting support of the LACWIB. Please allow a reasonable amount of time for a response. Letters of Support should be addressed to:
